# **American Law Reports**

#### What it Does

- · In-Depth Review of an Issue of Law
- Narrower coverage of topic than an Encyclopedia Article but comprehensive coverage of that topic
- · Leading Case Method





# American Law Reports

#### Parts of the ALR Set

- Eight Series including Federal
  - ALR 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th (state issues MOL)
  - Federal (federal issues)
  - International Law (\*new)
- Various Indexes BUT use the Multi-set Index
- Digests NOW use the West Topic and Key Number Digest
- Annotations Volumes
- Updating Pocket Parts and Supplemental Volumes



# **American Law Reports**

#### **Annotations**

- · Annotation
  - Analysis
  - Research References
    - Cases (by jurisdiction)
    - Key Number Digest
    - Related ALR annotations
    - Westlaw databases
    - Encyclopedia articles
    - Law Journal articles
- Case on which the annotation is based
  - Printed either with the Annotation or within the volume



# American Law Reports

#### **Research Method – Starting Points**

- Index
  - Multivolume Index for All Editions of ALR
    - Annotation History Table
    - All ALRs (even superseded ones)
  - Quick Index for Federal (located in by Fed. ALR)
- Use the ALR Digest
- ALR Citation (from another source)
  - Alert: Be Sure to Note the Proper ALR Series!



# American Law Reports

#### **Research Method**

- Locate and review Annotation
  - Consult Research References
  - Note cases in relevant jurisdiction
  - Note any additional ALR annotations
- Update research with appropriate tool

- Updated by pocket parts or cumulative pamphlets, or looseleaf pages



#### The Hornbook

Dr. Johnson described the hornbook as "the first book of children, covered with horn to keep it unsoiled." Pardon's New General English Dictionary (1758) defined it as "A leaf of written or printed paper pasted on a board, and covered with horn, for children to learn their letters by, and to prevent their being torn and daubed."

It was used throughout Europe and America between the late 1400s and the middle 1700s.

Shaped like an old-fashioned butter paddle, the first hornbooks were made of wood. The paper lesson the child was to learn was fastened to the wooden paddle and covered with a piece of horn. The transparent strip of horn was made by soaking a cow's horn in



hot water and peeling it away at the thickness of a piece of celluloid. The horn was necessary to protect the lesson from the damp and perhaps grubby hands of the child. Hornbooks commonly contained the alphabet, the vowels, and the Lord's Prayer. Later hornbooks were made of various materials: brass, copper, silver, ivory, bronze, leather, and stone.

As the art of printing advanced, the hornbook was supplanted by the primer in the book form we know today. Subsequently West Publishing Company developed its "Hornbook Series", a series of scholarly and well-respected one volume treatises on particular areas of law. Today they are widely used by law students, lawyers and judges.








- Use index(es) OR table of contents (or both)
- Locate material in main text
- To find cases
  - Appendix volumes
  - Pocket part
  - Softbound supplements

- Secondary authority until it is enacted by a state legislature





## **Uniform Laws & Model Acts**

- Uniform Laws Annotated
  - Set Index (pamphlet),
    - Directory of Uniform Acts
    - Jurisdiction Listing Uniform Acts Adopted
  - Value for Legal Research ...
    - If your state has enacted the uniform law, but the particular aspect of it that you are researching has not been litigated in your state, this helps you find cases from other jurisdictions that have adopted the law and addressed the issue and may prove to be persuasive to your court
